A Message from our Public Health Nurse







A 'strep throat' is a throat infection caused by the Group A Streptococcus (GAS). The strep throat bacteria are highly infectious. It can be spread when the infected person coughs or sneezes.

A strep throat infection can lead to rheumatic fever, even if it's the first time or a one -off. The risk of getting rheumatic fever gets higher when a person suffers from repeated untreated strep throat infections.

If strep throat is confirmed, children must stay home for 24 hours after starting antibiotic therapy.
