Mrs Bush's Very Special Reading Award

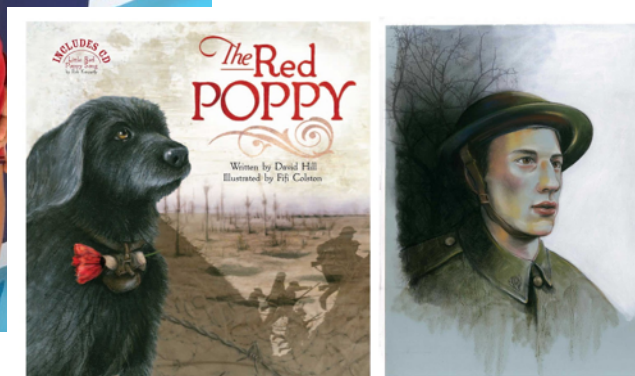
