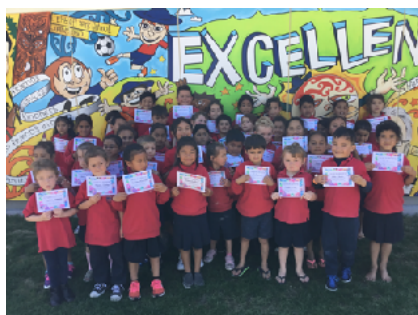

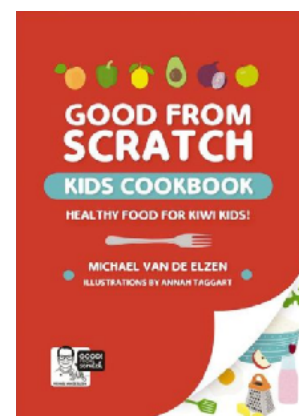
EXCITING NEWS - **FUNDRAISER** please support

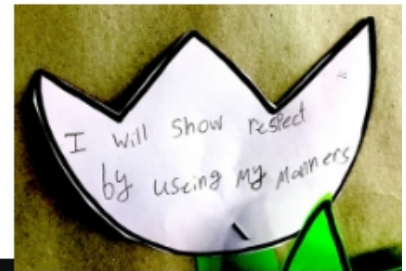


Last week we reviewed our respect lessons from Week 1 and Week 2.
