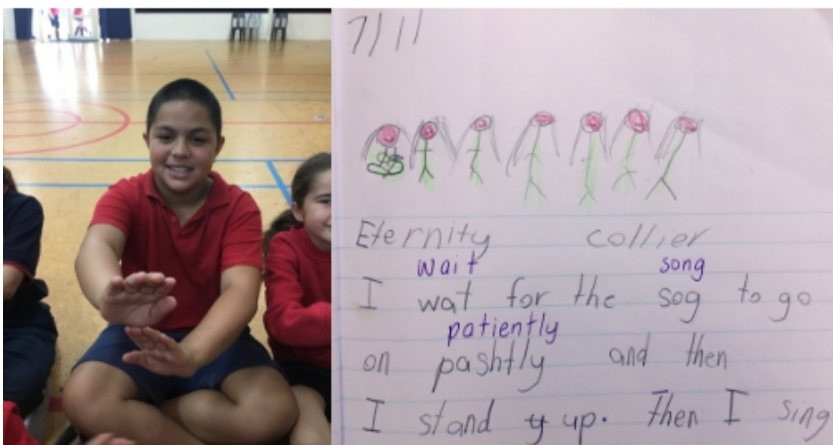
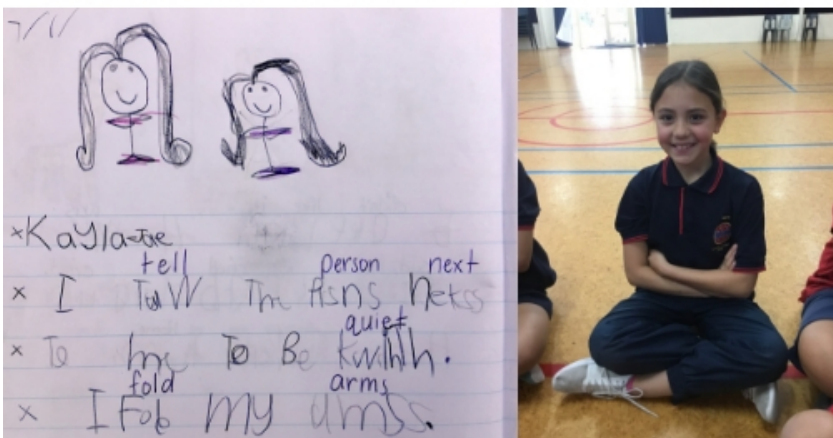
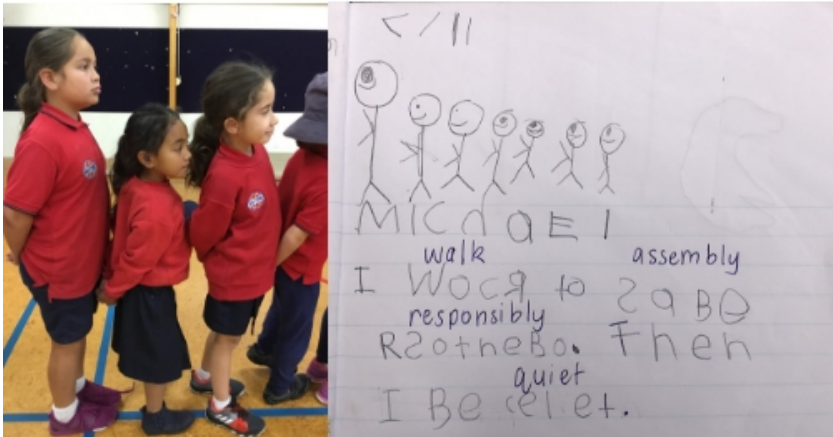
BEFORE SCHOOL EXPECTATIONS
