### SAFETY IN THE SUN



Protect tamariki from harmful UV radiation by being SunSmart, particularly between September and April

- ♥ **Slap** on a wide-brimmed hat or cap with flaps

- ♥ Teachers and whānau should slip, slop, slap and wrap too as healthy role models
- ♥ Develop a sun protection policy
- ♥ Become a SunSmart school
