A free app for us to share notices, for parents to sign permission slips and to inform us of your child's absences.



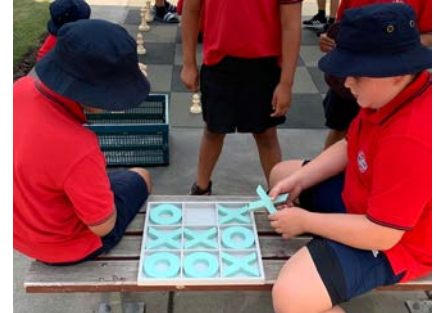
## Seesaw

### School Hats

Being term 1 hats are REQUIRED. We wear BLUE BUCKET hats. These can be purchased from the school office at \$8.00. Please ensure that your child/children have their hat so that they can be outside playing during our breaks and sport.

## Swimming

## Student IMMUNISATION - Action required
