A free app to access your child's learning and experiences while at Ebbett Park School.



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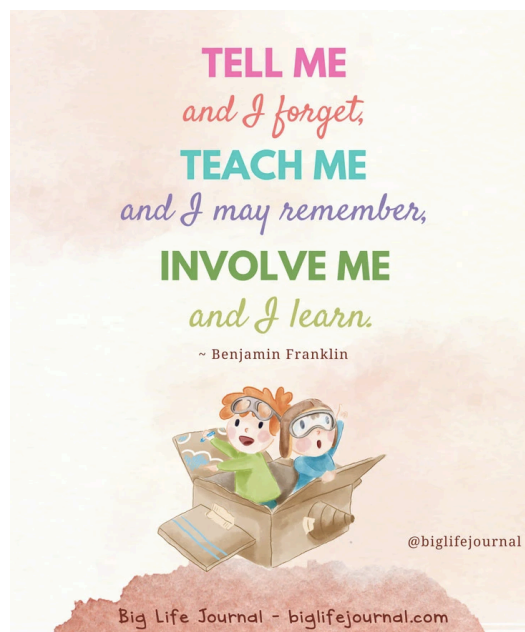
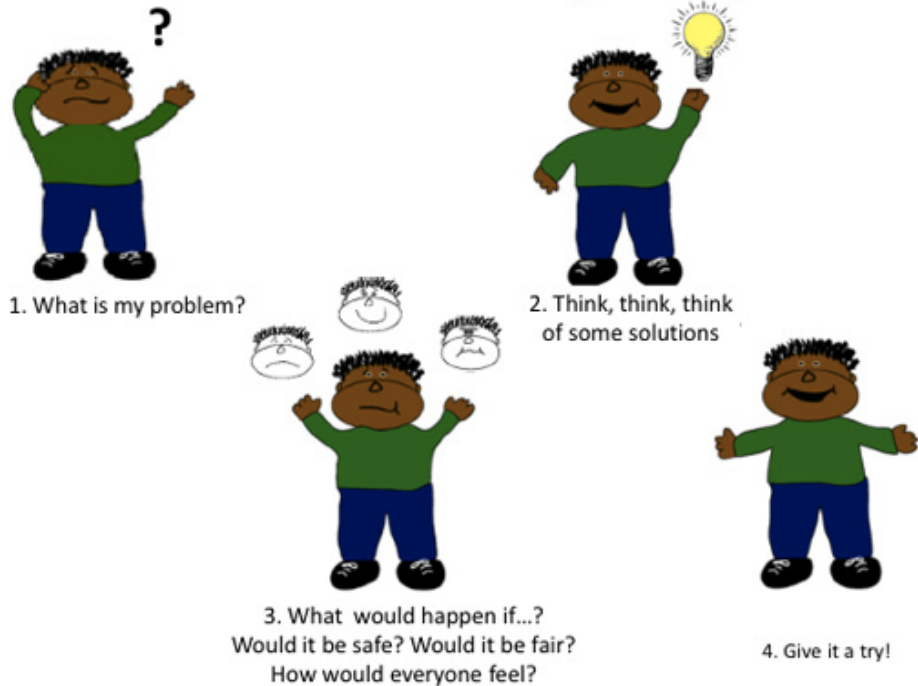
