Let's keep everyone safe

Visiting your school or early learning service

Please follow these simple rules:



Tell us your plans early

- Let us know early that your child will be attending so we can plan for them.



Essential visitors only

- Please ensure your visits to the school or early learning service are essential.
- Use the sign-posted entry point.



Drop off and pick up your child at the time you are given

- Your early learning service or school may require you to drop off or pick up your child at a particular time.
- Please help with staggered arrival and pick up times, if required.



Record your visit in the register

There are two registers:

- **Visitor register** - All site visitors must be recorded in the visitor register, which will record your name, time in and out, date, phone number and physical address. This assists with contact tracing if necessary.
- **Contact tracing register** - Your school or early learning service also keeps a register that identifies which children and adults are in each teaching space.



Maintain a 2 metre distance at all times

- Keep any on-site visit short.
- Maintain a 2 metre distance from those who are not part of your household, workplace or school bubble.



Sick children must stay at home

- Please keep children at home if they are sick. A sick child will be sent home.
- If your child is at higher risk of severe illness from Covid-19, they must stay at home.



Practice good hygiene

- Wash and dry your hands, cough into your elbow, don't touch your face.
- There's hand sanitiser available around the school or early learning service. Please use this if you touch surfaces.



Covid-19 cases

- You will be advised if your school or early learning service is connected to a confirmed or probable case of Covid-19. You will be advised of any actions to be taken.
- The site must close for 72 hours to allow contact tracing and cleaning. They may be physically closed for a further 14 days.

Please read the above information as it is important to know!

While we have a few families that require their child/ren to be at school during level 3 we would like to MINIMISE the number of people that enter our new school bubble. Please only come into school if it is TOTALLY NECESSARY - otherwise please use the phone.

To our families of learners RETURNING to school on Wednesday 29th April 2020

Thank you for letting us know that your child/ren will be returning to school. Please be assured that we have planned a comprehensive return to school for all staff and learners. We have established 'bubbles' that will have no more than 10 people in them (this includes the teacher)

Our school has been thoroughly cleaned. Sanitisers and signage is in place. We will be actively reminding everyone to keep up the physical distancing. Learners will have their own desk/seat in class and learning tools - sharing will not be allowed.

The ONLY entrance to school is via the Oliphant Road gate. The car park will be left free for those families delivering and picking up their child/ren at the staggered times as discussed. A staff member will be at the gate to sign them in and tell them which 'bubble' (learning space) they are to head to. Learners MUST go straight to that 'bubble' and NOT move around the school. Their bubble teacher will be waiting for them. We ask that parents do not enter the school ground.

The learners will be carrying on with the distance learning programme which has been provided by their own classroom teacher. It is important that each learner has everything they need for all their day. Uniform is not necessary at this level. School devices will be provided.

Bring: Morning tea and lunch, drink bottle (no fountains available), pencil case, something to do during the breaks - this needs to be something they can do by themselves.

To our families continuing with distance learning at home from Wednesday 29th April 2020

The learners will be carrying on with the distance learning programme which will be provided by classroom teachers.

Please be aware there may be changes to timetables and teacher availability as some teachers will be onsite with other learners.

Learning Packs and devices are still being processed by the MoE. Please let us know if you have NOT received anything by the end of the week.

Thank you for your continued support with your child's learning. This is a real team effort.
