Digital Learning and BYOD

At Ebbett Park School we are now requiring our learners to explore their learning, thinking, engaging with others and educational content via a digital device. This means that we will have in 2021 a BYOD (Bring Your Own Device) policy for our Year 4-6 students.



Year 4-5 – optional BYOD. Our Year 4 and 5 students have the option of bringing a digital device to school.

Year 6 – compulsory BYOD. Our Year 6 students are required to have a digital device at school.

At Ebbett Park School we use **Seesaw, ClassDojo and Skool Loop** apps to share learning, successes and to communicate with parents. When our child enrolls they will be given a handout with all the information needed.

The Ebbett Park School office will be open on Tuesday 8th December and Wednesday 9th December to help with enrolments for 2021.
