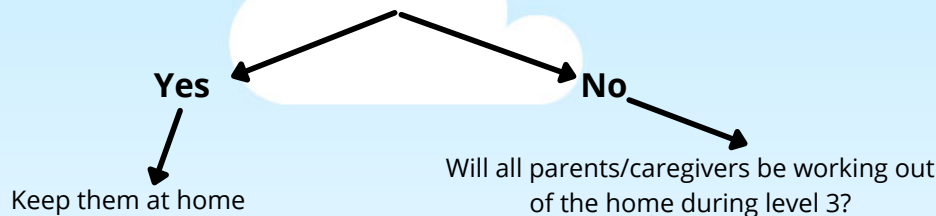




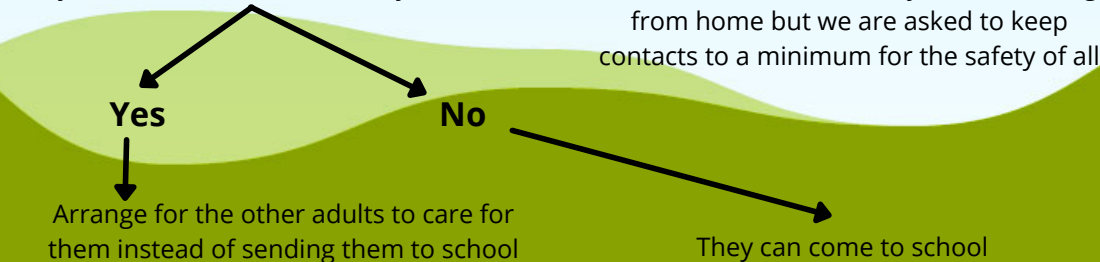

EXPECTATIONS at LEVEL 3

- All learners attending school in level 3 MUST have informed the classroom teacher by Tuesday 30th August no later than noon (12pm)

- No access to school for whānau only students.
- Only entry to school is via Oliphant Road entrance
- No road patrol will be operating
- Learners to be dropped and collected from the entrance way at the beginning of the driveway
