### Vaping Legislation

From 11 May 2021 under the Smokefree Environments and Regulated Products (Vaping) Amendment Act 2020, all schools, kōhanga reo, ECEs and kura must, in addition to the existing requirement to display 'no smoking' notices, display 'no vaping' notices. These notices must be displayed at every entrance to premises and buildings or enclosed areas on the premises (this excludes buildings and areas not usually in use).

**Schools, kōhanga reo, ECEs and kura will be sent (free of charge) no vaping/smokefree stickers between 30 April and 3 May 2021 in order to meet this legislative requirement.** The stickers are double-sided and can be used on windows and doors, including wooden doors.

If your school, kura, ECE or kōhanga reo require more stickers than you have been delivered they **will be available for order after 5 May** from this [link](#).
