Building Awesome Whānau provides **firm, fair and friendly strategies**

If you're looking after tamariki, the Parenting Place can help you become an awesome parent, grandparent or caregiver — even more awesome than you already are!

Whether you are a super-parent or one who is struggling, Building Awesome Whānau will give you lots of good ideas.

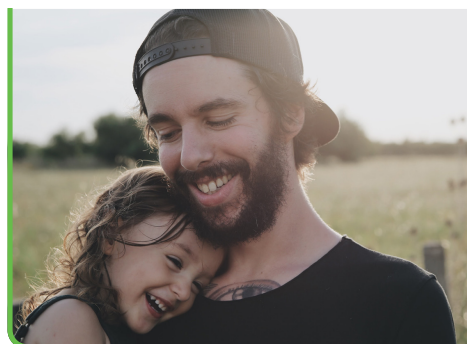
There are six sessions with a small group of other parents and a friendly facilitator. You'll watch short video clips together and then discuss how the ideas could work at your place.

Building Awesome Whānau was developed right here in Aotearoa. There are no tests, no judgement, no boring bits — just lots of fun and useful stuff!



Building Awesome Whānau covers:

- **Session 1 - Laying the foundations**  
Building your family on aroha
- **Session 2 - Parents are the roof**  
Protecting your whānau
- **Session 3 - The walls of the whare**  
Boundaries to keep the good stuff in and the bad stuff out
- **Session 4 - Keep it sweet**  
Atmosphere is everything
- **Session 5 - Cool korero**  
Communication
- **Session 6 - Outside the whare**  
Living in the big wide world



This course is free for:

- Parents
- Grandparents
- Wider whānau
- Caregivers

Building Awesome Whānau is great for relationships of all kinds.

A free book is included, and you receive a certificate when you have completed all six sessions.

Koha will be accepted to pay for any food or extras provided.





Here at Family Works, we have 3 amazing parenting programmes;

- Building Awesome Whanau
- Teenage Years
- Incredible Years.

The one I will be mainly talking about is Building Awesome Whanau.

BAW (Building Awesome Whanau) is a 2 hour, 6-session programme run over 6 weeks for parents/caregivers/grandparents and wider whanau of 0 - 10 year olds.

We do this in a group setting with a maximum of 14 participants and 2 fully trained and qualified facilitators.

There are 6 main topics we talk about;

- **Laying the foundations** - Building your family on aroha
- **Parents are the roof** - Protecting your whanau
- **The walls of the whare** - Boundaries to keep the good stuff in and the bad stuff out
- **Keep it sweet** - Atmosphere is everything
- **Cool korero** - Communication
- **Outside the whare** - Living in the big wide world

The reason we do this programme in a group is for the participants to get a wider view and see/learn from others, and to let them know that they are not alone.

This is a free course and at the end of the 6 weeks they will walk away with a fantastic manual that covers everything that we went through on the course, and much more.

As facilitators we make sure that everyone feels comfortable and understood. We tailor each session to what the group needs and deliver it in 3 different ways, Videos, Posters/brainstorming, and Verbally.

We offer both a day and evening sessions at our office 104 Lyndon Rd west and kai as well as we know some mornings parents are too busy getting their tamariki ready for school, they tend to forget to have breakfast themselves.

Building Awesome Whanau is also not just for people who struggle with parenting, but also for those who want to upskill their knowledge and gain more strategies.
