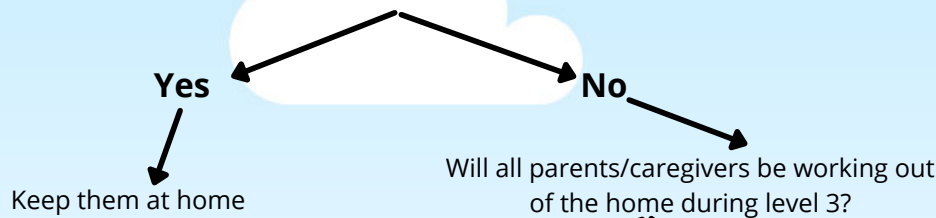

### ClassDojo

### Skool Loop

A free app for us to share notices, for parents to sign permission slips and to inform us of your child's absences.



### Seesaw

A free app to access your child's learning and experiences while at Ebbett Park School.



Please can you:

▶ **Confirm your child's/children's attendance at school during level 2. Do this via the teacher(s).**

▶ Be prepared for children to be working in classroom teams: Team 1: Year 5/6 (rooms 5 and 9), Team 2: Year 3/4 (rooms 6 and 10), Team 3: NE, Year 1/2 (rooms 4, 7 and 8).

▶ Understand that whānau will not be permitted into the school grounds nor will external agencies.

▶ Know that Entry and Exiting school will return to using both the Oliphant Road and Wall Road Gates.

▶ Road Patrol will be running.

▶ Remind learners that they are expected to go straight to class upon arrival at school. Teachers will in be the classrooms.

▶ Ensure that your child's uniforms are clean and tidy and ready to be worn correctly.

▶ Please inform us of any changes in address and phone numbers immediately.

▶ Ensure learners all have a drink bottle of water with them as drinking fountains will not be accessible.

▶ Ensure you child/ren have morning tea and know that lunch will be provided.

As soon as confirmation of a move to level 2 is announced more information will be provided to everyone.
