COVID UP DATE

TRAFFIC LIGHT SYSTEM AT A GLANCE

A new system for Covid-19 response will take effect when all DHBs across New Zealand have 90 per cent of their population vaccinated.



Red

- Working from home encouraged. Hospitality, retail, and gatherings allowed for vaccinated but with limits similar to level 2.
- For venues that don't use vaccine certificates - contactless pickup only for hospitality, gathering limit of 10, no gyms or hairdressers.

Orange

- Close to normal life for the vaccinated, with more masks required and some capacity limits.
- For venues that don't use vaccine certificates - contactless pickup only for hospitality, stricter gathering limits, no gyms or hairdressers.

Green

- Essentially normal life for the vaccinated, with schools, retail, hospitality all open with no limits.
- For venues that don't use vaccine certificates - some gathering limits, similar to level 2.

This is the new system that will be put into place when 90% of our population are vaccinated. When there is more information regarding this we will share it here so that everyone has access.

With our current level and restrictions we are unsure about what the end of term will look like for us. Over the next few weeks we will be working on an alternative plan for our end of year assemblies, Year 6 leavers dinner and 2022 classroom transitions. Once these plans have been confirmed we will inform everyone via this newsletter.

Whether you are a super-parent or one who is struggling, Building Awesome Whānau will give you lots of good ideas.

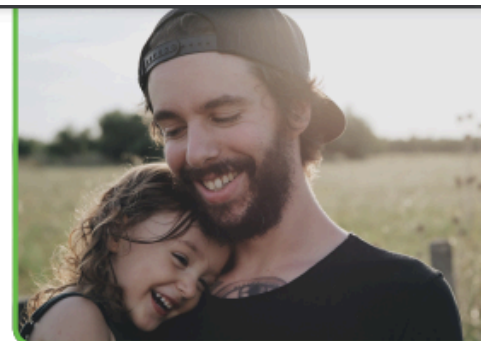
There are six sessions with a small group of other parents and a friendly facilitator. You'll watch short video clips together and then discuss how the ideas could work at your place.
