Ebbett Park School - Kia Whakatau te Hauora

Ebbett Park School have developed a programme that focuses on their whole school wellbeing. Twicetermly, Ebbett Park are hosting a 'Kia Whakatau te Hauora' afternoon. These afternoons are an opportunity for tamariki to choose an activity based around their interest, with a strong focus on their Hauora and wellbeing. They provide ākonga an opportunity to experience hauora their way, with activities based on Te Whare Tapa Whā. The options for tamariki include: play, Māori games, physical sport, mindfulness, gardening and yoga. These sessions will develop, and change based on student interest and needs, as well as the needs of the community. Whānau will be invited to play alongside their tamariki in future sessions.



Parenting is rewarding but hard work. The Incredible Years Parent Programme is a research-based programme for parents (or caregivers) who have young children aged from 3 to 8 years with challenging behaviours. The programme provides practical suggestions in every-day situations with a focus on you and your child's wellbeing.

Learning parenting skills in a supportive group is effective and fun. The facilitators will build on what you are already doing well and support you with different ways to manage your child's behaviour for the things that are not going so well.

Expressions of interest to the programme can be made by either the parent/caregiver or by others involved in supporting the whānau (with parent permission) by completing this form.

The programme helps to:

- Develop positive family relationships
- Provide whānau with new strategies to prevent misbehaviour
- Provide a support network for parents and caregivers
- Increase children's social skills at home, early childhood settings and school

What the course covers:

Parenting Skills:	
How to play with your child	Praise and rewards
Effective limit setting	Preventing and handling misbehaviour
Personal Skills:	
Communication, Problem Solving, Stress	Management, Giving and Receiving Support

Programme details:

- You are welcome to attend the programme if you are a mum, dad, grandparent or caregiver. Support
 people can come too but no children sorry.
- The group meets for 2.5 hours each week for 14 weeks with a break in the school holidays. You need
 to be prepared to attend all sessions.
- There is no cost to participate but you may have to think about costs related to childcare while you are at the weekly sessions, and the cost of getting to the venue. Sometimes we can help with this.
- It is run in a small group (14-18 adults), with 2 trained facilitators.

The Incredible Years Parent Programme in Hawke's Bay and Tairāwhiti is a joint initiative between Birthright Hawke's Bay, Enabled Wairoa, Family Works, Napier Family Centre, Te Taiwhenua o Heretaunga, and the Ministry of Education.
