REMINDER: Drainage Works on Oliphant Road

Hawkes Bay Infrastructure are to complete watermain, storm water and sewer connections from the property development area of Number 515 Oliphant Road, Hastings, opposite your school. There are 3 stages involved, Stage one is expected to take 3 days to complete, stage 2 will take 2 days and the final stage, 3 days to complete, weather permitting. **Work has started.**

The picture indicates the NO PARKING/STOPPING plan that will be in place during the works.

These learners will join the walking bus from Oliphant Road to the Southland Road crossing, with Mr Dufty, who will ensure they cross over and head home together.

4.Exiting school will continue to be staggered but as the times set here: **2.20pm: Off** site after school care, **2.30pm: Whānau group and 2.45pm those learner who are** the only family member at Ebbett Park School. This is aimed at minimising congestion on Wall Road.




