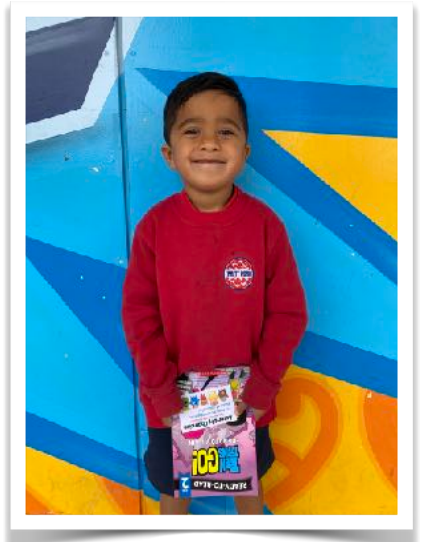
Classroom VIPs

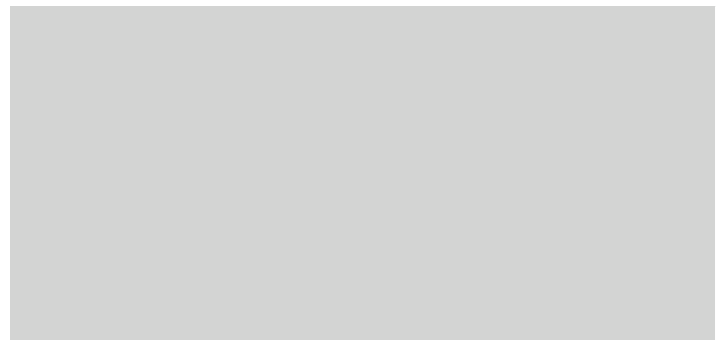

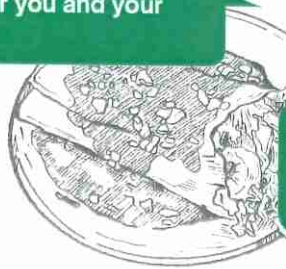
