Better Start Literacy Approach

This year, the teachers in Rooms 4, 7 and 8 will be implementing the Better Start Literacy Approach (BSLA). This is a Structured Literacy Programme. The Better Start

Literacy Approach Programme is designed for our children here in New Zealand. It has been trialled and developed with New Zealand educators, children and their whānau in schools. The children are assessed through the BSLA online lesson that the teacher's follow. There are decodable books that are directly related to the ongoing teaching.
