For any learner to be able to make the most of their time at school it is VITAL that they attend on a regular basis and are at school on time for the whole day. We ask that you consider any EARLY EXITS carefully and do NOT make them normal practice.

LATE ARRIVALS to school

Any learner that arrives after 9.00am on a school day MUST present themselves at the school office where they will be signed in on Vistab and eTap and receive a 'Sorry I am Late' card which they are to give their classroom teacher as they enter the classroom.

EARLY EXITS from school

Any learner leaving early **MUST** be signed out by the person or persons collecting the learner. The person or persons collecting a learner MUST present themselves at the school office first where they will sign the learner out on Vistab and receive a 'Signed Out' card which they are to give to the classroom teacher so that the learner can be released from the classroom.

NO learner is to be released from the classroom WITHOUT the presentation of the 'SIGNED OUT' card.

No child will be sent to the back gate to be picked up as we do not have visible sight of them.



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END OF DAY PICK UPs

End of day PICK UP - Wall Road

Whānau, thank you for your patience this afternoon during pick up at the end of the day.

We recognise the restrictions that having only one exit brings and have staggered exiting to combat the limited parking spaces.

Staggered Exit details:

2.30pm: Off Site After School Care students (YMCA and Elim when at home base)

2.40pm: Whānau Group - all siblings in the same family exit at this time.

2.45pm: Non-Whānau Group - learners that have NO siblings attending EPS.

It is VITAL that whānau follow these times as it allows for carparks to be created once the biggest group of learners have left.

Please DO NOT come early in order to get a carpark as this creates a parking problem for everyone.
