

KEEPING SAFE Expectations guring construction

We ask that you follow these expectations so that there are no accidents, incidents or hiccups please:

- 1. Oliphant Road Entrance will be closed to Staff and public from after Easter.
- 2. Entry to school will continue to be Wall Road ONLY.
- 3. Vehicle access via the Wall Road Driveway is limited to staff and construction Vehicles ONLY
- 4. Access to School grounds is limited to whānau between the hours of 8.30am 9.00am and 2.30pm 3.10pm. Hours outside of these this will result in the gate being locked.
- 5. Whanau collecting tamariki during school hours MUST contact the office and the child/children will need to be accompanied down to Wall Road for safe exiting.
- Any late tamariki will need to be supervised at the Wall Road entrance by whanau, who must call the office. A member of staff will walk to Wall Road to accompany the child into school safely.
- 7. Ebbett Park School to remain running the usual daily programme.
- 8. The school office will return to the front of the school. Please access this at the door by the library from the classroom Quad area.
